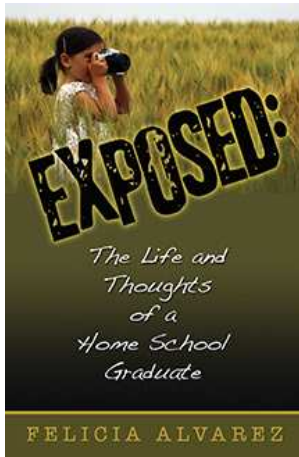


EXPOSED: The Life and Thoughts of a Home School Graduate
